Course Description and objective: The course will deal with the basic elements of Expository Preaching. Both the preparation and the delivery of expository sermons will be discussed with an emphasis on the preparation of sermons. Biblical texts will be examined and studied with the purpose of formulating expository sermons. Research methods and resource materials will be presented. The study habits of the

preacher will be dealt with. Different type sermons will be examined. The student should leave with an abundance of material on this vital area of ministry and a new passion for preaching the life-changing Word of God as would please our Lord.



Credit Hours: Three (3) toward *Master of Ministries* degree

Cost:

1) Those who will audit the class but receive no graduate credits

The total cost for the week is \$90.00. There is no registration fee for those who audit. You will be responsible to purchase your textbooks.

2) Those who will register for credit hours toward a Master of Ministries degree.

There is a \$25.00 registration fee and a \$125 per credit hour tuition fee. You will also be responsible to purchase your textbooks. All our master's classes are 3 credit hour courses.

Lodging: There is free lodging for a limited number of men. We will provide lodging on a "first come – first serve" basis as long as it is available. Requirements:

1. Read the textbooks Preaching that Pleases God and Anointed Expository Preaching **prior** to class. Record your reading as you do it by date and pages read. Turn in a reading report at the end of class on Friday. Those who register late will be given a two week grace period after the class ends to do their reading.
2. Read the textbooks Power in the Pulpit and Scripture Sculpture by **May 1**. Keep a record of the reading by page and date. This reading report should be mailed to the college address or emailed to Dr. Baker at mbaker@cbcking.org.

- The student will write five (5) sermons based on texts that will be assigned during the module. Three will consist of a detailed outline. Two will be written out in full manuscript form. The three (3) outlines will be due on **April 20**. The two (2) full manuscripts will be due **June 15**. These may be mailed to the college address or emailed to Dr. Baker at mbaker@cbcking.org.

Grading:

Reading of all the textbooks and turning in a reading report.....	40%
Three detailed sermon outlines	30%
Two sermons written out in full manuscript form	30%

Note: Those **auditing** the class are not required to do any of the assignments but are certainly encouraged to read several of the textbooks.
No reading report required. You will get all the handout notes, etc.
